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Possible Covid Classroom Scenarios

Scenario 1 (Non-mask)

If a student comes to school and shows priority symptoms as listed in the Covid Protocols & Guidelines Document - Other students with close contact for more than 15 minutes who do NOT wear masks in the classroom will be asked to guarantine and self monitor for 72 hours. If symptoms do appear during the first 72 hour time frame, your child will need to continue to be guarantined for an additional 72 hours priority symptom free. However, if your child does wear a mask, he or she will not be expected to self monitor at home and they will be allowed to attend school.

Scenario 2 (Mask wearer)

If your child is wearing a mask and has been in close proximity to a student who has shown priority symptoms of Covid and then your child shows symptoms themselves, they will be asked to self monitor for 72 hours priority symptom free.

Scenario 3 - Family Covid

If a student tests positive for Covid-19, the other members in their family will be required to stay home and self monitor for 5 days. Parents may have the option to keep the children home longer if they choose. If they are fever free for 5 days after the start of the positive Covid child's symptoms, the other family members can return to school.

High Priority Symptoms

- Fever (100.3 or higher) and chills*
- Shortness of Breath*
- Dry, persistent cough that leaves you short of breath*
- Loss of taste or smell*
- Nausea and vomiting*
- Diarrhea*
- Combination of symptoms*
